Dear Sir,

I am directed to inform you that the President, Board, in exercise of the powers vested in him under Section 28(2) of the West Bengal Board of Secondary Education Act, 1963, as amended, has been pleased to consider the report and recommendation of the State Govt. conveyed under the Education Department letter No. 75-SE(S) dated 7/19th February 1996 and to upgrade your school from 4-Class Junior High School to a High School with permission to open Class IX from 01.5.96 and Class X from 01.5.97 provisionally for three years subject to fulfilment of normal conditions enclosed. The school will send up 1st batch of candidates at the Madhyamik Pariksha (Secondary Examination) 1998.

The school is allowed to admit class VIII passed students of recognized 4-class Junior High Schools or recognized High Schools on the basis of valid transfer certificate within 16th May 1996 and should get those admitted students registered with the respective Regional Office in prescribed form with requisite fee within ten (10) days thereafter.

A report in the matter of fulfilment of conditions itemwise and seriatim attached to upgradation should be forwarded to the Board positively within six months, with a copy to both the Director of School Education, West Bengal, and the District Inspector of Schools (S.E) concerned.

The conditions attached to this Recognition as a High School are to be strictly complied with. In default, the Board reserves the right to cancel or withdraw recognition of the school.

The question of granting extension of the recognition of the school will be considered on fulfilment of conditions attached to this upgradation.

The school enjoying Board's permission for co-education at the Junior High School stage, has been permitted to introduce co-education in the upgraded classes and the said permission shall run concurrently from Classes V to X during the provisional period.

In view of the upgradation of the school the existing Managing Committee has been converted to an Organising Committee and allowed to function upto 31.10.96 with the direction to reconstitute the Managing Committee in accordance with the provision of the Management of Recognized Non-Govt. Institution (Aided and Unaided) Rules, 1969, as amended, within 31.10.96. The existing Administrator/Ad-hoc Committee, if there be any, has also been allowed to function upto 31. 10. 96 by which time the reconstitution of the Managing Committee of the upgraded school must be completed according to Rules.

You are requested to acknowledge receipt of this letter and return the enclosed Form No.83 and ST/2 duly filled in by return of post positively. The name of the school has been recorded in this office "ARIADHA MONIKUNTALA BALIKA VIDYALAYA."
